#### What is a Toastmaster?

Toastmasters International is an organization devoted to helping people like you to develop their leadership and communication skills. We do this by offering a proven plan to improve your speaking, listening, and leadership skills.

- Toastmasters International is a non-profit organisation with more than 300,000 members operating worldwide.
- At least one club is within a short distance from your home or office it's just right for you the First Hanseatic Toastmasters club!

Toastmasters is a fun way to improve your speaking and presentation skills. Each meeting provides an opportunity to practice impromptu speaking as well as prepared speeches. Whether you're a seasoned pro or a nervous novice, you will gain valuable skills and insight.

We have several contests, seminars, and conferences each year to develop your communication abilities. These events are great for networking and for taking your new found skills into the community.

# **Club Etiquette**

In order to benefit fully from your first meeting, please follow these rules:

- Applaud at the introduction of each speaker and again at the end of a speech. It is part of the nurturing environment that develops personal progress.
- Take part in the short improvised table topic questions.
- Vote for: Best Table Topics, Best Speaker, Best Evaluator.
- Ask our members questions before and after the meeting and also during the break.
- Let us know how our club can help you achieve your goals.
- Give us your feedback.
- Take part in several meetings as a guest.

You have taken an important first step towards improving your communication skills by asking about our programme. We then suggest the following:

- Determine where you stand as a speaker and form a written plan for the areas you want to improve in.
- Participate in our next meeting and speak to a member.

# **Timing**

All speaking roles are timed.



#### **Cast of Characters**

When you attend your first few meetings it will be helpful to know the cast of characters. Other than the President, people volunteer at a previous meeting to fill all the positions.

**President:** The most senior ranking officer present. Opens the meeting, introduces the Toastmaster of the Day, and conducts the business meeting at the end.

**Toastmaster of the Day:** The Master Of Ceremonies. the Toastmaster introduces the various participants in the meeting and leads the meeting.

**Table Topics Master:** The Table Topics Master helps members practice thinking on their feet. He selects topics of general interest and asks questions of members in the audience (You may be asked to participate).

**Speakers:** Typically there are three Speakers. Each one gives a prepared manual speech. Usually 5 to 7 minutes. Each speech has specific objectives that are listed in the Basic Manual (that's why it's called a manual speech).

**General Evaluator:** Provides constructive feedback on the meeting in general. He is in charge of the individual Evaluators and the Language Coach.

**Evaluators:** The purpose of the Evaluator is to motivate the Speaker to both continue speaking and to improve. The Evaluator lets the Speaker know what areas he has excelled in and also offers a few constructive suggestions to help the Speaker improve.

**Language Coach:** Listens closely to everything that has been said during the meeting, points out examples of good usage of English as well as usage that can be improved. This person also praises participants for using the Word of the Day.

Wizard of Ahs: Counts audible pauses such as "ah", "mmh" and "and".

**Timer:** Since one of the purposes of Toastmasters is to ensure our members learn how to express a thought within a specific time period, the Timer times, records and reports the time used by each Table Topic Speaker, Speaker, and Evaluator.

**Word of the Day:** Presents a Word of the Day, gives the definition and uses it in a sentence asking the audience to use it.

# **Mentoring Program**

Most new members join our club because they have problems or needs that relate to speaking. Also new members are not familiar with our club standards and customs or Pathways (the educational program of Toastmasters) and club meeting roles. To overcome those initial challenges and difficulties, our club offers a mentoring program.

"A mentor is a more experienced member who takes a personal interest in and helps another member. Mentors serve as role models, coaches, and confidantes, offering knowledge, insight, perspective or wisdom useful to the other member."

Mentors may also be assigned to more experienced members in case they need assistance in learning special skills, e.g. how to use humor in speaking.

In the back of this guest kit you will find a mentor interest survey. If you wish to have an assigned mentor please give the completed form to our Vice President Education who will take care of it.



### **Cost of Membership**

All members of First Hanseatic Toastmasters pay an initial membership fee (€30) plus semiannual dues (€66 for six months). The dues are calculated pro-rata based on the month in which you join and paid thereafter on a semi-annual basis for April - September and October - March.

**New Member Fee:** € 30.00

This fee is charged by Toastmasters International and is paid by new members only. It covers the costs of the New Member Kit and processing.

#### First Hanseatic Toastmasters Fee: € 11.00 per month

This fee goes to Toastmasters International and the First Hanseatic Toastmasters. It covers the costs of running our particular club, including supplies, room rental, special events, and more. Also includes a subscription to THE TOASTMASTERS magazine.
